Administrator's Report by Randall Oliver

Like all cities in Kansas, Cheney will be formulating the 2016 budget in the next six weeks. State budget problems have placed uncertainty on the School and City budget. The City will hold a budget workshop on July 6 at 7pm at City Hall. We invite all to attend the workshop so we can hear your thoughts and ideas as we try to improve our community.

Undoubtedly, you have seen various construction projects taking place around town. Work north of town on the Albers Finishing and Solutions building is underway and should be completed by year's end. City crews are installing the water main and will be extending natural gas service to serve this industrial park. Our city engineer is currently working on plans to extend sewer service to serve the industrial park. The sewer extension project will go out for bids next month. At the same time, city crews are extending the water main south of town along Main St to service the new Baseball and Softball complex.

You will soon notice construction in town repairing 55,000 feet of sewer line. Most of the repair is done on the sewer lines that were installed in 1920. This process will install a new liner inside of the sewer main to extend its useful life. Work will be done in the alley and rear utility easements.

We at the City welcome your thoughts and ideas to improve our community. Feel free to call or stop by if we can be of assistance.

Utility Extensions will no longer be allowed effective August 1st. All utility bills must be paid by the last day of the month or utilities will be shut off!

Fireworks

Individuals, who are at least 14 years old and under the age of 14 years old with adult supervision, may detonate fireworks:

<u>July 1st- July 3rd- 10 am – 10 pm</u>

July 4th- 10 am- midnight

- -If inclement weather prevents the use and discharge of fireworks on July 4th, the Mayor may notify members of the public that the dates may be extended to July 5th.
- -All **debris** from detonation of fireworks **shall be cleared** from yard and all adjacent public right-of-way.
- -It is unlawful for any person to discharge, ignite or fire any fireworks upon any public street, alley or avenue or in any park or public place within the city or within the fire zone of the city.

The line will be staffed July 3rd-4th from 6:30 pm-3:00 am. This line should be used to report fireworks complaints when nothing is on fire and nobody is injured, loud parties and general noise complaints where this is no disturbances or other illegal activity involved to the caller's knowledge.

Cherry Oaks Golf Course:

5 tips to help your lawn survive another Kansas summer.

- -Raise your mowing height: a higher cut lawn will help shade the soil, which will reduce the soil temperature.
- -Mow less frequently: avoid "routine" mowing, only mow if the lawn needs it. Use the one-third rule. Cut off no more than one-third of the leaf blade at a time.
- -Irrigation timing: avoid watering in late afternoon/early evening. Pre dawn/early morning is the ideal time to water your lawn.
- -Avoid summer fertilizer: the turf should have adequate nutrients stored to get through the heat.
- -Avoid herbicides when temps exceed 90 degrees: applying herbicides during high temperatures may cause unwanted injury to the turf.
