# **Administrator's Report**

City Hall will be getting a new look this summer as the Cheney City Council approved a bid from Aztec Stucco & Stone to stucco the exterior of City Hall. The project will take about 3 to 4 weeks to complete.

The Safe Routes to School project is still in the development stages and construction of the new sidewalks should begin this summer. Maps are located at City Hall with the proposed location for the sidewalks. Affected homeowners will be sent notices for another informational meeting after the plans are approved by KDOT.

The AT&T cellular tower construction has started. The foundation has been installed and the 300 foot tower will be erected in the next few weeks. This new tower will have the new 4g wireless service available in our area.

Upgrades to the swimming pool have been completed. Three nine foot diameter umbrellas have been installed to provide some shade on the north side. Installation of the ADA compliant pool lift to assist individuals with disabilities to enter the pool unassisted will be delayed due to a manufacture backlog. Improvements to the restrooms include baby-changing tables and fresh paint. Pool concessions will now be purchased from temperature-controlled vending machines to be installed and maintained by Wichita Vending.

There has been some discussion on installing a digital message board on Main Street with the final location to be at the Fire Station on Fifth and Main St. This sign will be paid for by the City with donations from the Chamber and Make a Difference Day proceeds. Copies of the sign policies and procedures are available at City Hall. You will be able, for a small fee, to advertise your (garage sales, anniversaries, birthdays etc) on the sign.

The City will also be replacing the street name signs on the west side of town. The new signs will be 9" tall with 6" letters. They will have a reflective surface and lettering for better visability at night. CHS students will cut the vinyl letters and install the names on the sign blanks for us. The Eagle Scouts will then assemble the signs on the brackets and the city crews will finish the installation.

We are also pleased to announce that KDHE awarded the City a 50/50 matching grant for \$12,738.50 to place recycled tire rubber mulch underneath the playground equipment at Budd Park.

The City of Cheney Community Cleanup Day will be **June 9, 2012 from 8:00am-11:00am.** 

FEES: CITY RESIDENTS

\$5.00/load for cars/small pickup trucks \$10.00/load for full size pickup trucks/trailers \$15.00/load for pickup truck with trailer (any size) \$30.00/load for large trucks (grain truck size)

NON-CITY RESIDENTS

\$10.00/load for cars/small pickup trucks \$25.00/load for full size pickup trucks/trailers \$35.00/load for pickup truck with trailer (any size) \$50.00/load for large trucks (grain truck size)

REQUIREMENTS: To receive the discount, you must be a City of Cheney resident & provide a copy of your utility bill. Those living outside the City limits will be allowed to dump but must pay the increased fee.No tires, household hazardous waste, liquid waste, batteries, appliances containing freon/refrigerants, concrete blocks, bricks or bulk quantities of construction materials.Tree limbs/brush needs to be hauled to the City Brush Site.

Now is the time to be thinking about summer insects in our lawns. Due to the mild winter that we had. I feel confident that insects will be of concern this summer. We are seeing increased grub worm activity in the turf at the golf course; they are higher in the soil profile than we typically see this time of year. Therefore, we will be applying our grub control 3-4 weeks earlier this y ear and may have to apply a second application to protect the turf. Now is the time to protect your lawn from insects.
